FEES AND LENGTHS CHARGED

Minimum length charged 5m (all boats). Boat length is measured overall including davits, bowsprits, stern drives, bathing platforms, etc, rounded-up to the nearest 0.2M. Dinghies and tenders must be stored aboard the vessel. All mooring fees are payable in advance. Any fees not paid in full in advance of the commencement date will incur an administration levy and will be charged at the Temporary Seasonal berthing rate.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

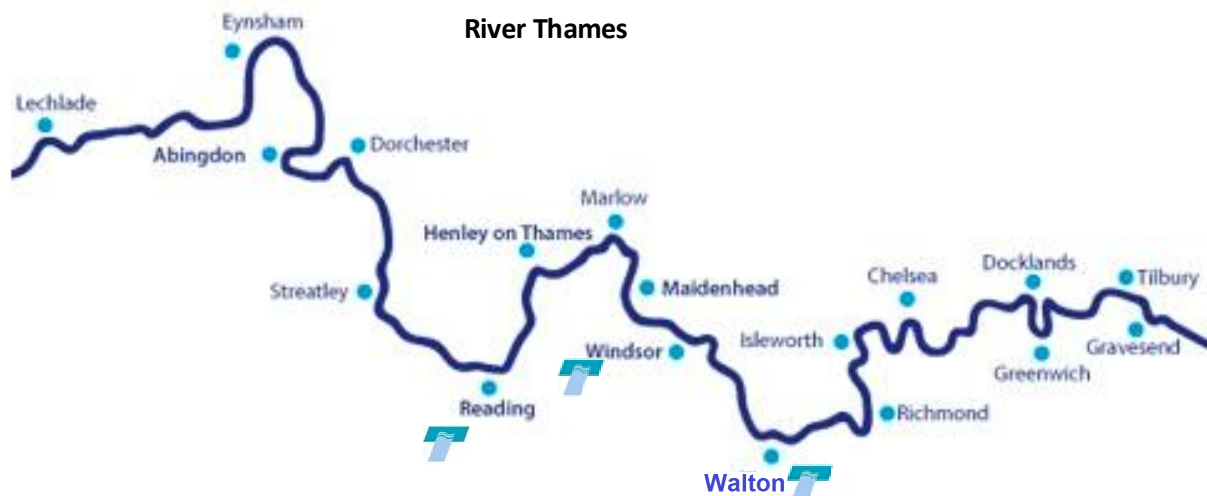

SAFETY NOTICE – PLEASE READ

Tingdene Marinas Ltd. ask all Marina Users to follow these simple safety measures:

Please familiarise yourself and all crew members with location of safety points as indicated on marina site maps, these are located next to the pontoon entrance gates to the North & South marinas.

The pontoons and walkways are slippery in wet or icy conditions; please take extra care. Please keep pontoons clear of all equipment and rubbish.

Children and non-swimmers must wear lifejackets at all times. Children must not be allowed to ride in the luggage trolleys. Bicycles must not be ridden on the pontoons or ramps. Do not run on the pontoons. Swimming is not allowed in the Marina basin. BBQs are not allowed on the pontoons.

In extreme weather and / or flood conditions lifejackets must be worn by all marina users. Ground anchors will be deployed during extreme flood and/or wind conditions, or when ice-covered the Marina will be closed to navigation. Please contact the Marina Office for current navigation advice.

Advice for the prevention of Weil's and other water-borne diseases. Weil's disease, also known as Leptospirosis, is rare in Britain with around 40-50 cases reported each year, however the disease does kill one or two people every year. It is carried by water organisms, so those taking part in water sports can be at risk. In the early stages Leptospirosis can be mistaken for flu but can develop into jaundice, kidney and liver failure. While the risk of contracting the disease from recreational water is very small, due to the potentially serious nature of the disease means that marina users must be aware of the dangers and should take simple, routine precautions to reduce the risk of infection.

- Never drink water from a river or lake
- If river water has been swallowed, refer to your doctor with full details of the incident
- Always shower after contact with the water
- Wash hands thoroughly and shower if necessary before eating or drinking
- Cover cuts and abrasions (including blisters) with waterproof dressings

Danger: the electric supply to the pontoons is three-phase mains. Do not tamper with the electric supply. Report all faults to Marina staff.

Dogs must be kept on a lead and not allowed to foul anywhere on Marina Grounds.

Please report any damage or faults to Marina staff as soon as possible.

All trade visitors must report to the Marina office prior to entry.

Do not discharge oil, sewage or any other pollutants into the Marina basin.

* Evacuate all pontoons and/or buildings. If your evacuation route from the pontoons is blocked, gather at the safest point on your pontoon and await rescue boat (Marina Workboat)

* Your assembly point is: Grass area on overflow car park
