## NEW LAUNDRY ROOM

We now have our new laundry room for your use.

There are instructions on the use of the washer and dryer but Chris or Mark can give you a hand with any info you may need.

The cost is £2 each use of a machine and we do have some combined soap and softener in the office for 50p for 2 tablets or feel free to use your own. Please close the door after you have finished.

We now have in stock the most popular Propane and Butane gas bottles which are used on boats. There is a price list on our notice board and we are giving berth holders a **5% discount** on the list price.



## SPEEDING

Unfortunately we still have regular complaints about vehicles speeding on the marina; this is especially an issue for people using the road round to the KQ moorings.

The excessive speed is not only a safety issue but also creates a lot of dust when driving on the gravel part of the road.

**Please keep to the speed limit, its there for a reason!**



## DOGS ON THE MARINA

Another issue that seems to be high on the list is dogs not being on a lead whilst on the marina.

Please make sure your canine friend is on a lead and report any offender to the office so we can deal with it.

This also applies to any owners who don't clear up after their dog and use the bins provided.



## BOAT TRAILERS

If you wish to store your boat in the compound over the winter on its trailer a charge of £16 per week will have to be made or other arrangements made to remove the trailer. We can accommodate trailers in the summer period free of charge to berth holders with smaller boats but we do not have the space needed for our winter package boats and while your boat has free hard standing, trailers do not.

If you wish to book a parking space for the winter please see Chris or Mark in the office.

## VEHICLE STICKERS

Could we also ask if you are displaying your Tingdene Parking Sticker in your vehicle? If not please call into the office to collect your free one.

This helps us monitor who should be using the car parking areas and remove anyone who should not be!

## CLEANING OF THE SHOWER BLOCK

There seems to be some confusion as to cleaning times of the shower block.

They do need to be checked and cleaned on a daily basis and a regular time that everyone is aware of is the best option.

**They are closed daily between 11am & 12noon.**

Also can ladies please make sure you use the bags provided for disposal of sanitary products before putting them in the bin.
