## Lengths Charged

Boat length is measured overall including accessories rounded-up to the nearest 0.2m; plus 0.4m for outboards and sterndrives; 0.6m for bathing platforms; 1.0m for davits and/or tender. Minimum length charged (all boats): 4.87m / 16ft.

## Terms and Conditions

All berth-holders agree to abide by the standard terms and conditions of mooring and storage as displayed in the Marina office. All owners are required to provide Insurance cover for third party claims of a minimum £3,000,000 and may be asked to produce evidence to this effect. Residential or Liveaboard use not permitted.

## Electrical Power Supply

Mains shore supply provided via standard 6amp MCB and metered lead or prepaid card. Prepaid cards are available from the Marina Office. Metered leads are provided by the Marina for a refundable deposit. Only metered leads provided by the Marina may be used. Boats found connected to shore supply without using a metered lead provided by the Marina will be disconnected without notice.

Refundable deposit on metered lead: £120.00 in advance (includes VAT at 20%).

*Please note that refunds on Metermaids previously issued at previous VAT will be refunded at the previous VAT rate, in accordance with HMRC guidance.*

Metered charge per Kwh unit variable to equal supply cost. Invoices for mains shore supply must be paid on receipt of invoice. Charges for metered units include standing charges, monthly demand charge, capacity charge, climate change levy, repair and renewal costs, NICEIC certification costs, maintenance costs and administration costs. The proposed charge from January 2020 is 12.66pence per KWh (includes VAT @ 5%) for electricity, plus 9.01pence per KWh (inc VAT @ 20%) for service charges. Total 21.67pence per KWh. This charge may alter without notice as supply costs alter.



*Important notice: Electric supply continuity cannot be guaranteed. Mains electricity is only available to boats with a properly equipped and protected ring-main installation. Electricity is supplied in accordance with OFGEM regulations.*

## How to reserve your berth at Pyrford Marina

- Visit Pyrford Marina and see all the facilities for boat owners as well as the beautiful setting. Please ask a member of staff to show you around the site.
- Ask for a quote for a mooring of your boat
- Check with Marina staff for the availability of a berth.
- Choose whether you would prefer to pay for your berth monthly or take advantage of the cheaper annual rate.
- Book your berth! Simply ask a member of the Marina Staff who will be pleased to complete all the paperwork with you.
- Make sure you have signed the mooring contract, as well as having adequate Insurance and River Licence. The Marina Staff can assist with all these.



### Informational tips

- The River Wey Navigation is the oldest navigation in the UK dating from 1653AD.
- It's also the most southerly inland marina in the UK.
- Pyrford Marina is approximately 2.5 hours cruising from the River Thames. (3 un-manned locks and 1 manned lock).
- The marina is approximately 6 hours cruising from Guildford town centre with all of the major stores and cinemas etc. that a major town can offer.
- A further 2-hour cruise will take you to the end of the navigation at Godalming.
- The nearest railway station is West Byfleet. This will take you to Waterloo in London.
- The A3 and M25 are only a couple of miles away, providing easy access north, south, east and west.
- There are local shops in Pyrford village with larger supermarkets in West Byfleet and Brooklands.
- There are pubs/restaurants within easy cruising distance. For example, The New Inn at Send is only 2.5 hours away so can be reached for lunch then turn around and return back to your berth.
- There are quite a few taxi services that come to the marina. 01932 850850 is one.
- The nearest petrol station is in West Byfleet only 1.5 miles away.
- The River Wey is constructed out of River and Man Made Canal sections. Pyrford Marina is situated on a canal section, so if the River goes into flood, it's still possible to cruise to Weybridge and back.
- If you're a golfer, the marina has 3 gold courses surrounding it, as well as a number of others that are only a short distance drive away (excuse the pun!).
